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One sheet per proposal: it is written down verbatim first, and only then is the objection question asked. **A proposal is decided once no serious objection stands against it** — and an objection counts as handled only once field 4 says what would have to change.

1	The proposal as it stood on the wall Verbatim, not summarised. If the proposal emerged in the conversation, it is written down here first and only then is the objection question asked.	
2	Objection question asked at Without a time there is later no evidence that it was asked.	
3	Objection (verbatim, no names) One objection per line; up to three lines. No objection: leave the field empty and fill in field 6.	
4	What would have to change for the objection to be withdrawn Only if field 3 has an entry. The answer of the person raising it. If nothing stands here, the objection was not handled but passed over.	
5	Change to the proposal Only if field 3 has an entry. The proposal after the change, verbatim again. A reversal is a new proposal and a new sheet.

7	Who did not speak The field is not an accusation; it makes visible the silence that would otherwise be counted as agreement.	People in the room: _____ Of those, no contribution to this proposal: _____
